What Jesus Meant

“Not every one that saith unto me,
Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom
of heaven; but he that doeth the will
of my Father which is in heaven.”

*Many will say to me in that day,

Jesus was not speaking to atheists.
He was speaking to religious people.
They called Him “Lord.”
They preached in His name.
They performed works that looked spiritual.

Yet He says something terrifying:
“I never knew you.”

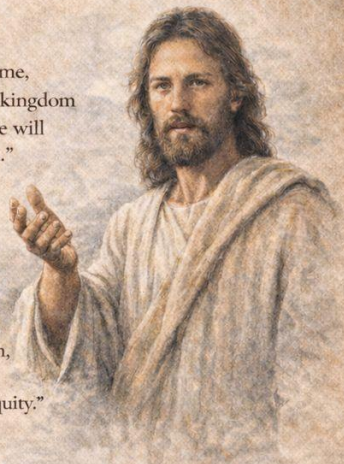
This passage does not say they failed to serve Him.

and still not be known by Him.

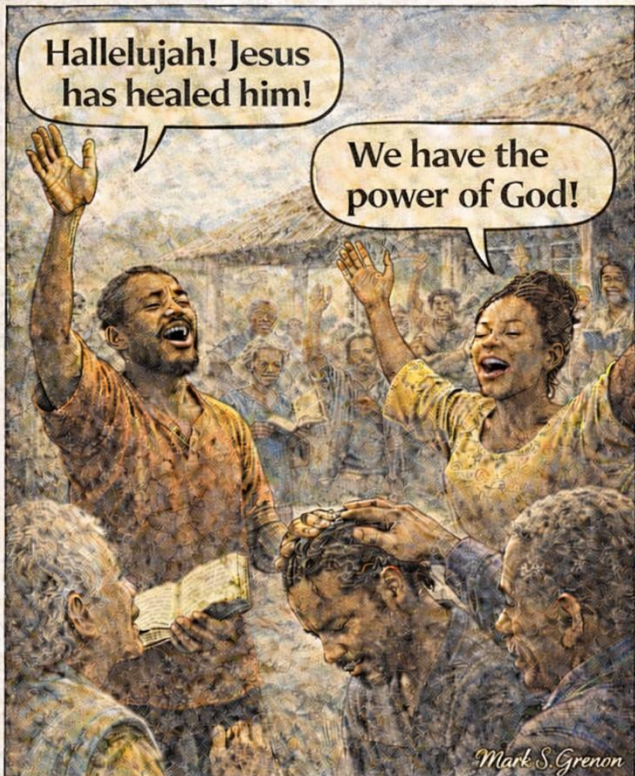

in the Old Testament.

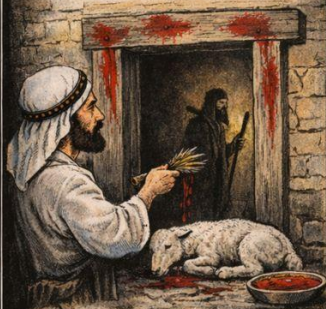


Their sins were only covered.

COVERED THEIR SINS FOR A TIME.**

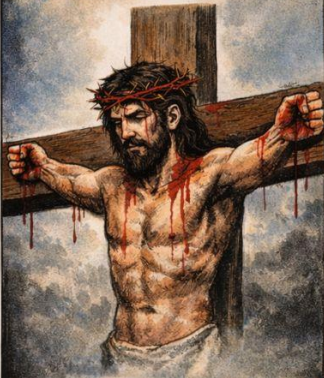

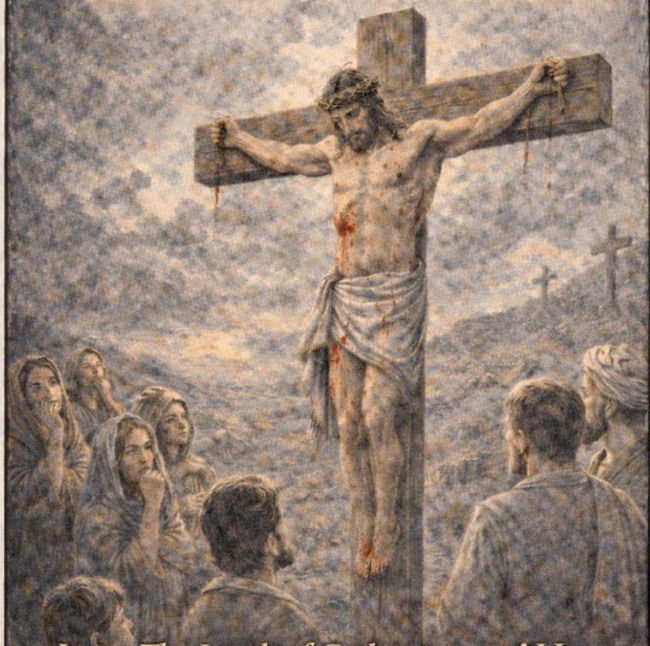

receive Christ.

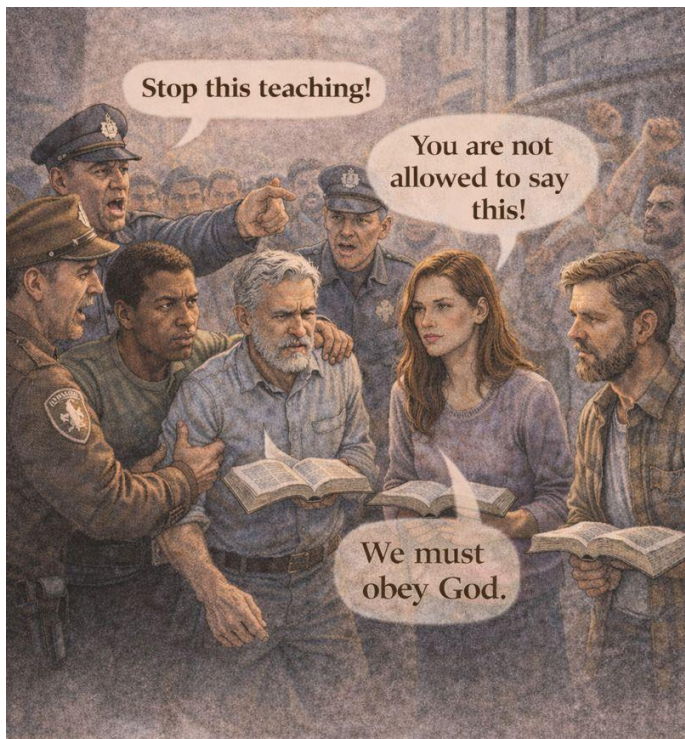
Repentance is

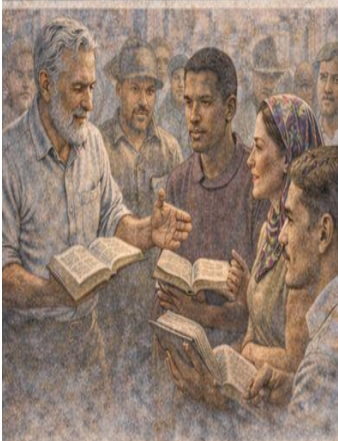
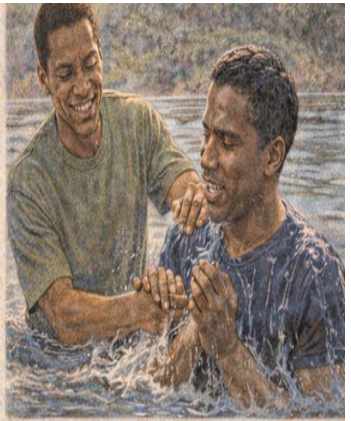

DENY JESUS OR DIE!



Romans 10:9–13 (KJV)

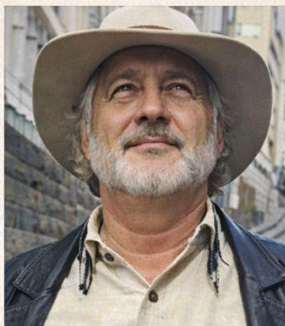
*That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus,
